



## Easy Quarter-Square Triangles.

Leading on from the half square triangles, you can take this another step further and create quarter square triangles.

### Step 1.

Cut a square 3/4" of an inch larger than the finished size of the piece including seam allowances.

(For a quarter square triangle piece to have a finished size of 2" then you need to cut the square  $2" + 1/2" + 3/8" + 3/8" = 3 1/4"$ )

### Step 2.

Cut two squares, one in each fabric that you are creating the quarter square triangles in.



### Step 3.

Draw a diagonal line across the back of one of these as in the picture and stitch a scant 1/4" either side of this line.



### Step 4.

Cut apart on the drawn line.



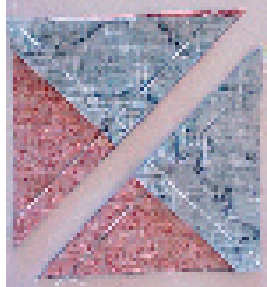
### Step 5.

Press the seam towards the darker fabric.



### Step 6

Place two of these right sides together, and feeling the seam matched up in the centre. Draw another line diagonally across the joined triangles, and sew a scant 1/4" seam either side of this line.



### Step 7

Cut apart on the drawn line.



### Step 8

You should be able to open this up and see a perfectly matched quarter square triangle.
