



Easy Half-Square Triangles.

This is a simpler way of creating half square triangles with no waste!

Step 1.

Cut a square $3/8$ " of an inch larger than the finished size of the piece including seam allowances.

(For a half square triangle piece to have a finished size of 2" then you need to cut the square $2" + 1/2" + 3/8" = 2 7/8"$)

Step 2.

Cut two squares, one in each fabric that you are creating the quarter square triangles in.



Step 3.

Draw a diagonal line across the back of one of these as in the picture and stitch a scant $1/4$ " either side of this line.



Step 4.

Cut apart on the drawn line.



Step 5.

Press the seam towards the darker fabric.
